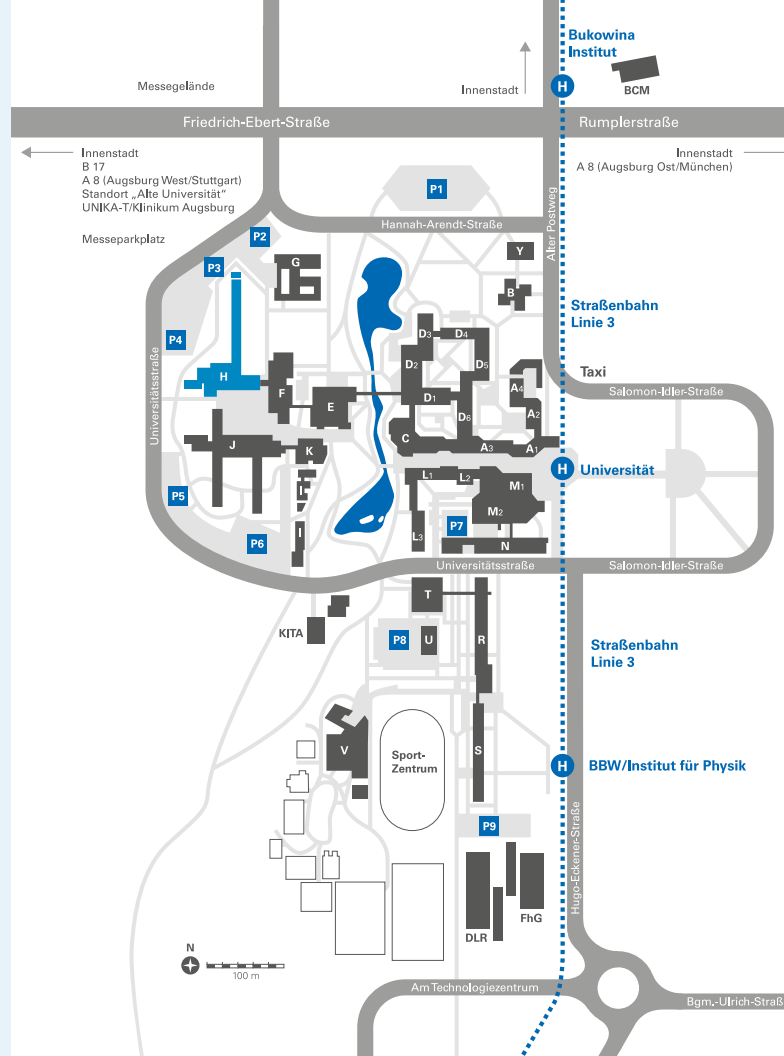


Excerpt of the Declaration of the leaders of 27 member states and of the European Council, the European Parliament and the European Commission (Rome, 25 March, 2017, 60th anniversary of the signing of the Rome Treaties):

“In these times of change, and aware of the concerns of our citizens, we commit to the Rome Agenda, and pledge to work towards: [...] A stronger Europe on the global scene: a Union further developing existing partnerships, building new ones and promoting stability and prosperity in its immediate neighbourhood to the east and south, but also in the Middle East and across Africa and globally; a Union ready to take more responsibilities and to assist in creating a more competitive and integrated defence industry; a Union committed to strengthening its common security and defence, also in cooperation and complementarity with the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation, taking into account national circumstances and legal commitments; a Union engaged in the United Nations and standing for a rules-based multilateral system, proud of its values and protective of its people, promoting free and fair trade and a positive global climate policy.”
