COPYRIGHT AND RELATED RIGHTS

Aims to align Ukraine's copyright laws with EU standards, strengthen enforcement mechanisms(combating piracy, counterfeiting, and copyright infringement, ensuring that intellectual property rights are adequately protected and enforced), protect copyright holders, facilitate market access, and promote collaboration between the EU and Ukraine in the field of copyright.

TRADEMARKS

The registered trademark provides the owner with exclusive rights. The owner has the authority to prevent third parties from using, without consent, any sign that is identical to the trademark for identical goods or services, as well as any sign that is similar to the trademark and creates a likelihood of confusion or association between the sign and the trademark. The duration of the protection - at least 10 years with the possibility for renovation



GEOGRAPHICAL INDICATIONS


Aim to safeguard the authenticity and integrity of products originating from specific geographical areas, facilitate trade opportunities, encourage collaboration between the EU and Ukraine, ensure informed consumer choices, and support the local economies and cultural heritage tied to these indications.





DESIGNS

Aim to ensure consistency with EU standards, provide robust legal mechanisms for design registration and enforcement, combat unauthorized use and copying, create opportunities for designers in both markets, and foster collaboration to strengthen design protection systems. The term of protection - at least 3 years.



PATENTS

Aim to ensure consistency with EU standards, establish robust patent frameworks, enhance cooperation and capacity-building, combat unauthorized use of patented inventions, create market opportunities, and foster innovation and technology exchange between the EU and Ukraine. Includes protection of biotechnological inventions, inventions in the field of health-care and related spheres.
