

# DCFTA AGREEMENT AND FASCILITATING UKRAINE'S COMPLIANCE WITH INTERNATIONAL LAW



#### **ACCESS TO GOODS MARKET**

Agreement incorporates relevant fundamental rules of WTO regarding non-tariff trade barriers, e.g., of national treatment, ban of import and export limitations, order of state trade. This also concerns reduction or cancellation of import and export duties.



#### **TRANSPARENCY**

Allows interested parties to **comment on draft legislation**; **set up information or contact desks**where information on any measures of general application could be received on demand; **provide due process** of considering cases, decision making, including review or appeal of administrative action.




#### **ENERGY TRADE**

Given into consideration the Ukraine's membership in the Energy Community, which obliges to implement the most relevant EU legislation regarding electricity and gas. This concerns internal price regulation, ban of double pricing, customs duties and payments, quantitative restrictions, transit, transmission and cooperation in infrastructure development.



### TRADE AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

Parties confirm their obligations to efficiently implement fundamental Conventions of International Labour Organization and ILO Declaration regarding the main principles and rights in the labour field. The goal is to strengthen ties in the area of trade, environmental security and social policy and to promote further the extending of Ukraine-EU trade.



## TECHNICAL BARRIERS IN TRADE

Parties of Agreement confirm their obligations in terms of the WTO Agreement regarding technical barriers. Harmonization of technical standards would reduce the existing non-tariff barriers in trade, increase the goods' quality on Ukraine's internal market and encourage the development of Ukraine's positive image on international market regarding the quality of goods.
